- 3. We understand what leadership will be required and are confident that our decision-making institutions






Time Since First Case





#### RUNNING OUT OF TIME...

+2.4T tonnes/CO<sup>2</sup> since mid-1800's

Average global temperature already +1.1°C

Global carbon budget = 400B tonnes (66% chance of 1.5°C)

Annual emissions = 40B tonnes so < 10 years

## FRE

Irreversible changes on timescales of centuries to millennia Oceans & ice absorb 96% of global heating = ↑ melt & sea levels

#### Globally 1990-2014

- Produced capital/person (roads, buildings, factories) 个 x 2
- Human capital/person (health, knowledge, skills) 个 13%
- Natural capital/person (sources, regulators, sinks)  $\downarrow$  40%

#### **INSTITUTIONAL FAILURE: \$4-6T/year 'perverse subsidies'**

- 1. Increase Nature's 'supply' & ensure demand does not exceed supply
- 2. Change our measures of economic success from GDP to natural capital
- 3. Systemic & Institutional transformation

#### PHYSICAL RISKS


Extreme events and chronic ecosystem services changes due to the condition of natural assets.

NATURE-RELATED FINANCIAL RISKS



#### TRANSITION RISKS

Resulting from the process of adjustment towards an economy that engages more sustainably with Nature. These include policy changes, shifts in market preferences, societal norms and technology.



Radical new legislation, financial costs and Court cases e.g. Shell in Netherlands



#### LITIGATION RISKS

Legislation and fines for damages to natural assets.



#### **SEVEN GENERATION THINKING**






